FUBAS

- All PhD courses will be entered into a GU-system called FUBAS.
- The information about courses will be entered here either by the examiner of the course, or with assistance from any of the director of studies.
- Students will be able to search for and apply for courses <u>here</u>.
- All students at Chalmers, GU and at other universities that want to have credits for the course will have to apply for the course in FUBAS.
- The examiner will either accept or reject students.
- Accepted students will register through Ladok.

- To increase the quality of PhD studies.
- To ensure that every aspect of the PhD studies is followed up and to have more focus on the overall goals of the PhD studies.
- To make sure that every PhD student receives good supervision and clear information concerning the requirements and expectations.
- To ensure that the process to continue the employment contract of a PhD student works well.
- To strengthen the research environment by having more contact between researchers.

Desired outcome

- Have a common view of PhD studies within the faculty (clearer expectations than today)
- Increased quality of PhD projects (feedback on research related questions from more people and early on)
- Improved working environment (more support both to the PhD student and the supervisor)
- High quality follow-up of the PhD studies

Suggestion (general model)

- A committee consisting of
 - director of studies (chairman)
 - supervisors (main and co-)
 - examiner
 - faculty member

assigned for each PhD student

 PhD student meets with the committee regularly (the schedule planned with the times of the continuation of the employment contract in mind)

At the follow-up meeting

- The PhD student him/herself presents his/her progression and how he/she will reach the goals
- Focus will be on the goals and on the PhD student's journey towards becoming an independent researcher
- Individual study plan (ISP) will support everybody's work
